

Mental or Physical Impairment

The goal of Albatros Expeditions is to provide a safe comfortable cruise experience for all guests; however, guests must realize that there are inherent risks associated with traveling on board ships that are unique to expedition cruise travel. These risks can include but are not limited to the following: steepness of the gangway, weather, shore-side facilities, tidal and sea conditions. It is vital that the guest notifies the agent of any impairment (physical or mental), in writing at the time of booking! Guests needing any form of assistance, and those who live with a mental or physical impairment must be accompanied by someone who will take full responsibility for any needed assistance during the cruise and in the event of an emergency. Moreover, guests requiring a wheelchair must provide their own collapsible wheelchair.

The decision to allow any guest to board a Zodiac or disembark the vessel will be made by the ship's Captain or Expedition Leader on the basis of the safety and welfare of all involved and is final.

If guests are unable to use the Zodiacs or disembark because of circumstances outlined above, will not be refunded or credited for missed ports/landings. While Albatros Expeditions recognizes your disappointment the safety of both guests and crew takes precedence.

At the time of booking, we informed you about the nature and form of the expedition cruise. You have confirmed in your final booking, that you are willing to participate as part of a group and that there is no possibility to take special account of your physical ability.
